For your own safety: Muzzle, extra Leash, Collar, Harness

Dressings & Bandages

Adhesive Tape, Band-Aid, Elastic Bandages, Triangular Bandage, Gauze Pads, Gauze Rolls, Non-stick Pads, Baby Socks for paws

Cleaning Supplies & Disinfectants

Paper Towels, Disposable Gloves, Hand Sanitizer, Povidone Iodine, Pre-soaked Wipes or Swab Sticks (Iodine & Benzoin), Colloidal Silver 500 ppm, Antiseptic Wipes, Cotton Balls, Q-Tips, Ear Cleanser (10% Apple Cider Vinegar & Water), Eye Saline Drops, Syringe without needle for puncture wounds, Saline Wound Flush

🔮 🔹 Instruments & Tools

Scissors, Plastic Forceps, Nail Clipper & Sand Paper/File, Digital Rectal Thermometer, Tweezers, Tick Removal Tool incl. Lighter, Headlamp incl. extra batteries, Wooden Tongue Depressors, Small Tongs, Razor, Blanket to transport large dogs, Towel to create sling to assist dog walking, Zip-Log Bag to collect samples of vomit, stool, poisonous substances or dead snake for identification

Wound Care & Bleeding Control

Antibiotic Ointment, Styptic Powder/Stick, Quik Clot Sport Sponge, Vetbond Glue, Farm Dog Restore, Coconut Oil, Sting or Rope, Rubber Bands

Poison Control & Burns

Activated Charcoal to absorb certain substances, Hydrogen Peroxide 3% to induce vomiting (only after consulting with vet or poison control center as some substances can cause more damage!), Vinegar or Baking Soda to neutralize acid burns

Allergy, Insect Stings & Bites

Benadryl, Vaseline, Snake Bite Remedie Lachesis Mutus 30C*

Anxiety & Shock Treatment

Homeopathic Aconitum for shock, Bach Rescue Remedy, Farm Dog Relax Formula or Lavender Oil, Diazepam 5 mg*, Survival Rescue Blanket

Inflamation, Fractures, Pain Management & Heatstroke

Instant Cold Pack & Warmers, Tramadol 50 mg*, Traumeel (tablets or drops), Medi-Lyte Tablets or Coconut Water & Bottled Water for dehydration
